**Updates/Opening Remarks:** Ken Fralick opened the meeting at 7:30pm.

1. Ken informed the meeting of the following recent updates at Leaside Towers
  - Upgrades to the entrance of the recreation center are completed
  - 85 parking garage fans are being repaired
  - Parking entry “arms” are being repaired
2. Tenant comments and questions were raised and will be reported to management
  - #95 B1 entry door doesn't lock
  - Complaints about cars speeding in the garage
  - Request to have grass mowed around dog run
  - Fobs no longer display green light when used at garage exits/entries
  - Complaints about noise levels from some tenants after midnight – tenants are advised to keep a log of times & dates and calls to security and follow up with this information at the Morguard
3. Pat Wright reported that there will be no movie screenings during the summer months. Ian added that he and Andrew will be posting lists of Classic films and ask for requests from tenants
4. Ken attended the two public meetings that took place in March re Thorncliffe Park area issues and reported on them. There has been no progress made on the promised improvements to Burgess Park.
5. Ken introduced Elizabeth Sarjeant of The Blue Dot Movement, an organization under the mentorship of the David Suzuki Foundation. Her presentation detailed their goal to have the Canadian government enact an Environmental Bill of Rights to insure protection the our environment for all of us.
